Faculty Development as Change Agent: Transforming Schools and colleges into Learning Organisations

This famous quote comprehends that True education is one which ignites the fire of inquisitiveness and the spirit of inquiry in a person. Therefore, to keep the spirit always ignited DME takes immense pleasure to proclaim that the Multi-Dimensional Leadership Conclave (MDLC) 2022 organised yet another compelling Panel discussion on the theme “Faculty development as change agent: Transforming schools and colleges into learning organisations” on 6th August 2022 at 2pm in Studio 62, DME campus.

The esteemed panelist included Ms. Taruna Kapoor, Principal, GD Goenka Public School, Ms. Richa Sharma, Principal, Raghav Global School, Ms. Megha Singh, Vice Principal, Gagan Public School and Prof. RaviKant Swami, Director, DME. The moderators of the session were Dr. Shalini Gautam and Ms. Shanu Jain

The first round of the discussion focused on the Transformative Training for Change Agents, Developing Socio- economic, Critical and Team Building skills. Ms. Richa emphasised on the significance of continuous professional training with need analysis for developing technical skills for the faculty. In order to think beyond the classroom, traditional programmatic practices that can evolve by interweaving learning and experience for an intentional and seamless development of trans disciplinary competencies among future sustainability leaders. Ms. Taruna splendidly expressed the importance of happy teachers, creating happy classrooms and reinforcing the importance of socio-emotional skills and "life skills sessions" in school, as she strongly believed in the adage “what you sow, is

what you reap”. Ms. Singh shed light upon the primacy of critical thinking skills for problem solving and decision making, as well as providing a congenial environment for students in order for them to reciprocate. Dr. Ravi accentuated on the centrality of team building and mutual cooperation in leading the team to success. As “Alone we can do so little, but together we can do so much”.

In round 2 the panelists shared their experiences and recommendations for strengthening faculty development at Individual and central levels. Ms. Taruna shared her thoughts to have a budget to make teachers upskill as teachers are the foundation of any educational institute. In other words, “Dedicate yourself to continuous personal improvement, you are your most precious resource.”

Ms Megha reiterated on the significance of having inhouse seminars to upskill Teachers and inculcating on a continual basis as Life is all about becoming a better version of yourself. Ms. Richa focused on planning well to make thyself free from emotional burnout and aiming at boosting creativity of teachers, giving them space for personal development, outdoor sports activities and collaborative learning between school and college teachers is a sure recipe for success.
